JUDDMONTE STALLIONS

Welcome

Last year, we celebrated Juddmonte's landmark 40 years in thoroughbred breeding. This year, we have sadly lost our founder and owner, Prince Khalid. On behalf of everyone who has worked for and with him at Juddmonte over the past 40 years, we feel privileged to have played a small part in his passion for breeding and racing. His contribution worldwide to the industry will stand the test of time: the outstanding owner/breeder of this and perhaps any generation. He is greatly missed.

Poignantly, this is the year that FRANKEL is destined to become Champion Sire in GB and IRE as well as Europe – the first time in 34 years that a British-based stallion has been Champion Sire since Mill Reef in 1987, an achievement that would have given Prince Khalid great pleasure and satisfaction. This was also the year that Frankel became the fastest European-based stallion in the history of Pattern to sire 50 Northern Hemisphere-bred Group winners.

After what has been an extremely challenging 18 months for our industry, it was tremendous to finally connect in person with our fellow breeders and friends this year at some of our racecourse sponsorship events, on the stud and at the sales. There is no doubt our sport is the richer for social engagement, closer interaction and sharing our passion for the extraordinary thoroughbred.

The Juddmonte stallions' statistics on an international level are noteworthy to say the least, with a remarkable 154 Group winners between them to date.

KINGMAN's runners have enjoyed tremendous results, achieving lifetime figures of an outstanding 12% blacktype winners to runners. In 2021, internationally he has sired three Group 1 winners on three continents, Palace Pier, Domestic Spending and Schnell Meister, and 18 stakes winners in total.

In the sales ring, KINGMAN's progeny shone through. At the Arqana August Yearling Sale, his filly out of Needleleaf, a close relation to the unbeaten dual Group 1-winning two-year-old Native Trail, consigned by Haras d'Haspel realised €950,000. His daughter out of Finsceal Beo was the second highest-priced filly on Day 1 of the

Goffs Orby Yearling Sale at €500,000. Day 2 of the Tattersalls Book 1 Yearling Sale produced a real highlight when a colt out of multiple Group winner Turret Rocks reached 1,100,000gns and, in Book 2, a yearling out of Australian-bred Reem went to 525,000gns. Success from his progeny in the USA also encouraged multiple purchases destined to be trained and raced there – as conveyed by Mike Ryan (p.37) “We have found that they train well on the dirt in the mornings and excel on fast ground in the afternoons...” We look forward to following these purchases in their progress in 2022.

2021 also saw multiple Champion and eleven-time Group 1 winner Enable visit KINGMAN and we are incredibly excited at the prospect of seeing her first colt or filly this coming year.

Remaining as Europe's leading sire of Group 1 speed, OASIS DREAM consistently produces top class results both on the racecourse and as a broodmare sire. No other stallion has sired the winners of more Group 1 sprints in Europe in the last 10 years. A highlight of this year has been witnessing dual Group 1 winner Native Trail, who is his best ever two-year-old on Timeform ratings and goes into 2022 as the ante-post favourite for the 2000 Guineas. In the ring, Native Trail was the fourth highest priced colt in the Tattersalls Craven Breeze Up Sale and his top yearling sold for 420,000gns in Book 1 of Tattersalls October Yearling Sales, bred by Mr Paddy Burns. In addition, Group winner Grocer Jack, bred by Dr Christoph Berglar, topped the Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sale selling for 700,000gns and is destined for Saudi Arabia.

There has been notable success for BATED BREATH, especially for Juddmonte's third generation homebred two-year-old Sacred Bridge. The winner of four of her five starts, including an emphatic victory in the Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes at the Curragh, we look forward to her performances on the track in 2022. In North America, Space Traveller, bred by the El Catorce Partnership ran second in the Gr.1 Woodbine Mile Stakes, and our homebred Viadera and Gift List, bred by James Ortega Bloodstock Ltd both reached Gr.2 glory at Saratoga and Churchill Downs respectively.

His progeny were also high achievers attaining the highest priced filly (blacktype performer Breeze Easy) at the Tattersalls Ireland Breeze Up (relocated to Newmarket) at £240,000 and a 230,000gns full sister to Gr.3 winner Simply Breathless at the Tattersalls October Book 1 Yearling Sale.

Impressive Breeders' Cup Mile winner EXPERT EYE's first yearlings went through the ring with some excellent uptake from the domestic and international markets. He covered 50 Group/stakes winners in his first two books of mares - more than Acclamation (11), Dark Angel (12) and Mehmas (13) combined; 55 yearlings sold with an average of £43,729. A number are on their way to the USA thanks to Kenneth McPeck, Niall Brennan and Ramiro Restrepo, who emphasised: “Seeing his stock in person made them even more appealing to American turf racing”. We are looking forward to his first runners in 2022 with great anticipation.

And then FRANKEL. He sired his 50th individual Group winner when Cheveley Park Stud's Inspiral won the May Hill Stakes (Gr.2). She later maintained her unbeaten record becoming his 20th individual Group 1 winner when emphatically taking the Fillies' Mile at Newmarket. Inspiral goes into winter as the ante-post favourite for both the 1000 Guineas and the Oaks. Her exploits helped Frankel become the fourth leading sire of 2yos in Europe - and was one of three 2YO Gr.1 winners sired by him worldwide. Dominance of the Classics has also been a feature – siring two different horses to win the Derby and the Irish Derby in Adayar and Hurricane Lane (who claimed his second Classic when winning the St Leger). At Royal Ascot, FRANKEL topped the leading sires table with three winners, two seconds and a third. Kirsten Rausing's homebred Alpinista emulated her granddam Albanova with three dominating Group 1 victories in Germany this season. He also came out on top in the Southern Hemisphere, where his Australian Oaks-winning daughter Hungry Heart, bred by Yulong Investments, has been crowned Australian Champion three-year-old Filly.

Thank you to all breeders that supported the Juddmonte stallions in 2021. We look forward to seeing the results of your efforts in due course and assisting you with your nomination plans for the new season.

PROGENY SUCCESS

Australia

Fresh success on the track alongside a continuing appeal in the sales ring has all added up to another strong year for Juddmonte stallions in the Southern Hemisphere.

FRANKEL's stature grew yet further, thanks to Hungry Heart who was named 'Champion Australian Three-Year-Old Filly' in 2020-21. In the space of two wonderful weeks last April, the Yulong Investments homebred recorded back-to-back Gr.1 triumphs in the Vinery Stud Stakes and the Australian Oaks.

Converge was another Gr.1-winning 2YO who excelled for Frankel 'Down Under', while his filly Steinem was Gr.2-placed. OASIS DREAM's Turaath, bred by Shadwell, relocated to Australia for her four-year-old season and was victorious in the Gr.2 Let's Elope Stakes at Flemington.

A sales highlight for Frankel came in May when his filly out of liex Excelsa sold for A\$530,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Weanling Sale. Also in 2021, the unbeaten champion's three-parts brother Maximal arrived on Australian shores during October. In an exciting initiative, Maximal is now owned in partnership by Juddmonte and Rosemont Stud where he will stand after his racing career with trainer John O'Shea concludes – thus giving Southern Hemisphere breeders access to a superb bloodline.

BREEDER INSIGHT

Anthony Mithen

Anthony Mithen's passion for Frankel has extended beyond sending mares to the stallion at Banstead Manor. Geelong-based Rosemont Stud – where Mithen is principal – in 2021 secured a partnership with Juddmonte to race and then stand Frankel's three parts brother Maximal.

Trained by Sir Michael Stoute in 2020 and 2021, the Galileo colt out of Joyeuse (ex Kind) was fourth in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes at Royal Ascot and then second to Baaeed in the Sir Henry Cecil Stakes at Newmarket. Maximal has resumed racing with trainer John O'Shea in Australia, ahead of the second part of the plan which is for the horse to undertake stallion duties in Victoria at Rosemont Stud.

“The Maximal project is one of the most exciting things we've done at Rosemont,” says Mithen. “It's spine-tingling to think we have partnered with one of the global breeding giants on a horse with his profile, good looks, form and bloodlines. To be joined at the hip with Juddmonte on the three-quarters brother-in-blood to the mighty Frankel, to race him together into what will certainly be his finest season, and aim him at some of the big prestige and money races in Australia is simply incredible. I can't thank trainer John O'Shea and his assistant Tom Charlton enough for helping pull this together and give Rosemont and our partners the opportunity to bring Maximal to Australia.”

“I think if we can get him to show his best on the racetrack in Australia, breeders will have no choice but to fall in love with him. By the best stallion of this generation in Galileo, from an exceptional female pedigree, a light-on-his-feet medium-sized equine athlete – what more can you want. Oh, did I mention he's a close relation to the best we've ever seen on the track, Frankel!”

In recent times Rosemont have supported the Juddmonte stallion by sending mares to him at Banstead Manor. Mithen acknowledges that it's a sizeable commitment and brings its fair share of challenges, but believes that the effort is well worthwhile.

“There is always the underlying question for commercial breeders: will the market understand the horse that we have bred when it gets onto Australian shores? That said, when you can tap into the best bloodlines and centuries worth of breeding brilliance, the costs of getting a mare to the UK or buying one up there and exporting down-under pale into insignificance if your mission is to breed the best,” is Mithen's take.

“Juddmonte have been tremendous to deal with. Nothing seems too hard and I have appreciated the banter and information swap between the sales team and myself, especially with Shane Horan. Would you believe, we randomly met leaning on the running rail together about to watch a race at Randwick several years ago. We got chatting and turned out we were destined to do some business.”

Grocer Jack (OASIS DREAM) proved a hit on the racecourse and at the sales. The four-year-old was never out of the first four in six Group races, winning a Gr.3 in both Italy and Germany. He duly went to the Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sale and was knocked down as the sales-topper at 700,000gns.

BREEDER INSIGHT

Philippa Cooper, Normandie Stud

For Philippa Cooper there was a special poignancy to Hurricane Lane's magnificent victory in the 2021 renewal of the Grand Prix de Paris.

On a summer's evening at Longchamp, her Normandie Stud-bred Frankel colt out of Gale Force gave one of those superlative displays that really defines a top-notch Group 1-quality performer. In seemingly effortless fashion, Hurricane Lane backed up his Irish Derby win with a six-length triumph. Those are the facts that will stand indelible in the history book, but it was the personal details that served to intensify the emotions for Cooper last July. "It was the story behind Longchamp, the story of my youth. I went to a French school, the French Lycée in London and studied French at university," explains Cooper, who would become a French teacher.

"My father loved racing. When we used to go to France, to Paris, we'd go racing... Longchamp, Maisons-Laffitte, Chantilly on the Sundays in July. It was the time of Yves Saint-Martin. So, when Hurricane Lane won at Longchamp it meant a tremendous amount to me, just like when Duncan won the Prix Foy. We seem to have this thing that we continually want to please our parents even when they're dead."

Cooper sums it succinctly: "It's all stories," — and her own is remarkable. Normandie Stud (that French connection again!) was established with one mare in 1997 and has become a hugely-respected entity with the focus very much on quality rather than quantity. At the moment Cooper has 13 mares.

Over the years a strong alliance has been forged with Juddmonte. Indeed, in 2012 Cooper's homebred Fallen For You (Dansili ex Fallen Star) gave both parties a huge thrill with victory in the Group 1 Coronation Stakes at Royal Ascot. "I really liked Dansili because I'd watched him in the Breeders' Cup and he so nearly won," she recalls. "For me, it's so much about seeing the racehorses and being swept away. He was an owner-breeder's stallion."

In 2021, Cooper didn't just have one Frankel colt to enjoy as a proud breeder, but two as Mohaafeth (ex French Dressing) also proved himself a high-class performer with a Royal Ascot success in the Gr.3 Hampton Court Stakes. And her Kingman filly Love is You, a Listed 2YO winner racing in Normandie's distinctive pink and white silks, was also Group-placed in the Nell Gywn Stakes, before meeting with a setback. "I had 10 — six boys, four fillies. 33.33 per cent were Group horses," is Cooper's proud assessment of the achievements recorded by Normandie's 2018 foals.

The future looks just as bright with Cooper especially excited about three Kingman fillies that will turn two for 2022. They are out of Fallen For You, French Dressing and Fleur Forsythe and she has kept them all with the future in mind. "I really should have sold one or two of them. But then I thought I need to race these girls because my mares are going to start to get older and I need young blood."

BREEDER INSIGHT

Kirsten Rausing, Lanwades Stud

The 'A-L family', as Kirsten Rausing refers to it, is admired by many and runs deep in quality. And in 2021 it received yet another upgrade, thanks to Alpinista.

A fourth-generation homebred from Miss Rausing's Lanwades Stud, the daughter of Frankel delivered a hat-trick of German Group 1 victories. One of those wins came in the Preis von Europa in Cologne, a Group 1 that her grand-dam Albanova also landed some 17 years earlier. A neat nod to history, indeed.

Naturally, Alpinista's progression as a four-year-old has delighted Miss Rausing. But it came as no major shock to the owner-breeder or trainer Sir Mark Prescott, based on the evidence of those generations that had preceded the filly.

"This branch of the 'A-L' family does mature," explains Miss Rausing. "Not that it's maturing slowly because Alpinista was a winner as a two-year-old on her debut (at Epsom, in July 2019), beating colts. But it maintains progress, so I was always fairly confident in Sir Mark's appraisal of the whole thing. We were not so surprised."

Sir Mark also trained Alpinista's mother, Alwilda. A 2015 Listed winner in Cologne, she visited Frankel the following spring.

"She was a high-class race-mare herself and daughter of a champion race-mare, horse of the year," says Miss Rausing. "So I suppose I was just looking for a sire that was at least as good, or better, than the mare. That narrowed the field considerably.

"Everything has been said about Frankel. But I think one thing I could say about him is that he was a world-class racehorse and, frankly, is now the emerging prime heir to his legendary sire."

Miss Rausing remains a strong supporter of Juddmonte stallions – not least Oasis Dream, whom she first sent mares to in his initial season as a sire. Indeed, her homebred Starlit Sands (*ex Shimmering Sea*) was Oasis Dream's very first winner in May 2007. The filly would go on to become the then freshman sire's third Group winner (*after Visit and Young Pretender*).

"She is still very much working away and is grand dam (through Lanwades' homebred Seychelloise) of this year's good two-year-old Sandrine, a dual Group winner," outlines Miss Rausing, who has also bred two other Group winners by Oasis Dream – Lady Jane Digby (Group 1) and Shine So Bright (Group 2).

"It goes both ways, I'm glad to say," she adds. "I've also very much appreciated Juddmonte's support of my stallions. In particular Selkirk, from whom they bred the 1000 Guineas winner Wince, Kirkwall (*multiple Group winner*), Cityscape (*Dubai Duty Free winner*) and Orford Ness (*Group 3 winner*) amongst others. So we've had long and fruitful cooperation. I'm delighted that we've had such success both ways."

PROGENY SUCCESS

Japan

Japanese interest in FRANKEL has been there since his early days as a stallion. Indeed, his first ever Gr.1 winner came in Hanshin in 2016, courtesy of the 2YO filly Soul Stirring. She went on to become his first Classic heroine, landing the Japanese Oaks in Tokyo the following year. His first crop was notable, too, for Mozu Ascot, who won at the highest level in Japan in both 2018 and 2020 over a mile on turf and dirt.

Frankel's son Grenadier Guards was also a 2YO Gr.1 victor at Hanshin late in 2020 but he had to settle for third place behind KINGMAN colt Schnell Meister in the Gr.1 2021 NHK Mile Cup in Tokyo.

Kingman's appeal is ever-increasing in Japan where his reputation received another boost through the Gr.2-winning filly Elizabeth Tower. And demand for Frankel was underlined by his lone foal in the JRHA Select Sale 2021. The colt bred by Northern Farm realised ¥240million, equivalent to £1,571,566.

BREEDER INSIGHT

Northern Farm

Northern Farm has developed into a global success story since it was founded in 1994. The Katsumi Yoshida-owned operation, which is now run jointly with his son Shunsuke, has about 1,000 mares in Hokkaido and has bred a long line of stars, such as Deep Impact, Delta Blues, Admire Moon, Cesario, Gentildonna, Lys Gracieux, Almond Eye, plus the 2021 Breeders' Cup heroines Loves Only You and Marche Lorraine.

"Our company goal is to, 'share our happiness from our horses to people throughout the world,'" says Shingo Hashimoto, Northern Farm's manager of international affairs.

"One of the ways to achieve this is to win big international races such as the Arc, Breeders' Cup – like we have had success in the Melbourne Cup, Cox Plate, Dubai Turf and the Sheema Classic etc.

"In order to do so, we will need to breed the best, most competitive horses in Japan. And we are always seeking that opportunity by purchasing high-quality mares and breeding them with the best stallions such as Frankel and Kingman."

In recent times, the strategy has been rewarded with Northern Farm's homebred Grade 1-winning colts Grenadier Guards (ex Wavell Avenue) and Schnell Meister (ex Serienholde). Wavell Avenue, a Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (Dirt) winner, was sent to Frankel in 2017 – the same year that Group 1 German Oaks heroine Serienholde was mated to Kingman.

"We had been visiting Juddmonte for decades and we know not only the high quality of the stallions but also all the high standard of the workers, stables, pastures," explains Hashimoto. "So in terms of sending the highest-quality mares that we own, it was not a difficult decision to make.

"We were really excited when we purchased Wavell Avenue and we wanted to breed (her) to the best stallion, so in 2017 we sent her to Frankel. For Serienholde, since she was a winner of the Preis der Diana, we thought she had great stamina and we wanted speed, so we wanted her to be covered by Kingman. Those were the specific reasons for those two mares."

In December 2020, Grenadier Guards won the Grade 1 Futurity at Hanshin. In May, 2021 he was narrowly beaten into third by none other than Schnell Meister in the Grade 1 NHK Mile Cup in Tokyo.

Those results are satisfying in their own right for Northern Farm. But what makes them especially valuable for the future is that, in Japan where Sunday Silence has ruled supreme for so many years, the two colts will offer new opportunities for breeders.

"In Japan, ever since Sunday Silence was imported, he was a complete game changer and he still is dominant," says Hashimoto. "Almost all horses winning a Grade 1 race in Japan have Sunday Silence in his or her pedigree.

"In that sense, Grenadier Guards and Schnell Meister are both 'Sunday Silence-free'. But we knew that high-quality mares covered by high-quality stallions would be successful. And we are very excited that such a point was proven. We also think that both have a promising future as sires, since they are Sunday Silence-free, and can cover many top-class mares in Japan.

"To raise the level of racing in Japan to a higher level in the long term, refreshing or varying the pedigrees will be essential. And I believe the key to achieving that is having access to stallions like Frankel and Kingman."

And as for Northern Farm's basic objective, that's simple: to keep achieving.

"We hope the success will continue, and our farm will be as good as it can be in the next 100 years," sums up Hashimoto.

The rise of KINGMAN in America was evident in 2021 with his son Domestic Spending to the fore once again. A Gr.1 winner late in the previous campaign, he came out and registered two more top-class triumphs. Public Sector and Technical Analysis gave the Banstead Manor stallion additional success at Gr.2 level and Kingman's appeal for the American marketplace was emphasised when Lexington-based bloodstock agent Mike Ryan bought seven by him at Book 1 of the latest Tattersalls October Yearling sale. "They train well on the dirt in the mornings and excel on fast ground in the afternoons...they are a trainer's dream," is Ryan's clear and concise evaluation of the sire's progeny.

Meanwhile, Frankel's merits were showcased in Canada with the Gr.1 victory of his 2YO filly, Wild Beauty at Woodbine. And classy Juddmonte homebred mare Viadera (BATED BREATH) was still putting her best foot forward as a five-year-old, winning in Gr.2 company at Saratoga. Gift List, also by the same stallion, was another to strike in the same grade in North America, while European Gr.2 winner Space Traveller was Gr.1-placed at Woodbine.

BREEDER INSIGHT

Peter M. Brant

In the 1990s Peter M. Brant opted for “a vacation” from racing, choosing to pursue his other equine passion, polo.

At that point the American industrialist and entrepreneur had accomplished a long list of triumphs as an owner-breeder. Not least among his achievements was breeding 1995 Kentucky Derby winner Thunder Gulch – and also that horse’s sire (Gulch) and dam (Line of Thunder). How do you top that?

“I figured I would take five, ten years,” says Brant of his self-imposed break, “That wound up being 20.”

“When the Wildensteins decided to exit from horse racing and had their dispersal that really kind of acted as a catalyst to get me back in,” he recalls. “I thought very much of those bloodlines even though they were quiet for about seven, eight, ten years. I learned a long time ago that these bloodlines sometimes, if you change the breeding around – the type of horses they’re breeding to – that you can revive them.”

He is currently enjoying the progress of Serve The King, a son of Kingman that White Birch Farm secured for 260,000gns in 2017 at Book 1 of Tattersalls’ October Yearling Sale. In the fall of 2021, the lightly raced colt was runner-up in the Gr.1 Joe Hirsch Turf Classic at Belmont Park.

“I like Kingman a lot,” says Brant. “When I bought Beauty Parlour, she was in foal to Kingman – the Wildensteins obviously liked him. And I see that Chad is doing very well with Kingmans.” Brant also owns her daughter, Blowout (Dansili) who became a Gr.1 winner in 2021.

White Birch Farm’s well-bred broodmare band is split between Europe and the USA. Brant likes to keep the number at around 60. He started sending mares to Juddmonte not long after returning as an owner-breeder. But his appreciation of the operation and its founder extends back a lot longer.

“I was following Prince Khalid Abdullah from the beginning because I was involved kind of about the same time he got involved in horse racing,” explains Brant, who historically had plenty of horses trained this side of the Pond. “I always had great respect for the operation. I was breeding in Europe and we were buying mares in Europe – so I had that connection.”

Some 40 years on and Brant’s connections to European racing and breeding are exceptionally strong. Such links include a steady support of Banstead Manor Stud, through use of Frankel and Kingman. “I think Elmer Fudd would say that those two are great stallions – anybody could see that,” jokes Brant, wryly referencing Bug Bunny’s famous old adversary.

“I would say, compared to when I was younger, I’d multiply it by three,” assessing his love of racing, offered with a chuckle. “I thought I spent too much time when I was younger with it, but probably spend more time with it now than I did back then. I just love it. It’s very, very exciting – and I enjoy the people.”

AGENT INSIGHT

Mike Ryan

Lexington-based bloodstock agent Mike Ryan has been a fan of Kingman since the days when the Juddmonte homebred lit up racecourses. “He was an absolutely brilliant racehorse,” says Ryan, who was born and raised in the thoroughbred industry on his family’s farm in County Meath, Ireland.

That admiration has very much continued through Kingman’s stallion career, right from his very first crop to sell in 2017. Since then Ryan has signed for a steady supply of yearlings by the Banstead Manor Stud sire, including Domestic Spending, Technical Analysis and Public Sector, all of whom have been Graded Stakes winners in the United States for owner Klaravich Stables and trainer Chad Brown.

So what are the attributes that Ryan, a breeder himself, pinpoints in Kingman’s progeny? “They are beautifully made horses” he says. “They consistently have a lovely profile and are light on their feet. We have found the Kingmans to be agile, athletic and easy to train. They are willing, have a great appetite for training and carry that work ethic forward to the race track. They are just competitive, reliable horses with a great turn of foot.”

Ryan saw from the first crop of Kingman that they would be suitable for American turf racing.

“We have found that they train well on the dirt in the mornings and excel on fast ground in the afternoons. The Kingmans have shown tactical speed, travel well in their races and can accelerate from a high cruising speed. These attributes enable them to compete at the highest level. They are honest, courageous and have a big heart. Like Kingman himself, they demonstrate a lot of raw natural ability, and they always show up.”

Ryan backed up his belief in Kingman at the latest Tattersalls Book 1 sale, buying no less than seven of the sire’s progeny. Recognising the tremendous success Kingman has had in the United States, Ryan believes others will seek to import his offspring. “They are a trainer’s dream – they show up and most certainly have not let us down.”

PROGENY SUCCESS

United Kingdom

FRANKEL chalked up a notable landmark in 2021 when unbeaten two-year-old filly Inspiral became his 50th Northern Hemisphere-bred Group winner with victory in the May Hill Stakes at Doncaster. She went on to win the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket. The Juddmonte stallion recorded no less than eight new Gr.1 winners in 2021 including Derby, and King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes winner Adayar, who became the first three-year-old since Galileo in 2001 to achieve this momentous double.

The two-year-old colt's division was headed up by Native Trail, an outstanding son of OASIS DREAM. His excellent victory in the Dewhurst Stakes capped a brilliant season in which that scintillating Gr.1 performance at Newmarket resulted in him becoming Oasis Dream's highest-ever rated juvenile.

Palace Pier (KINGMAN) lit up the miler ranks with a Gr.1 hat-trick across the Lockinge Stakes, Queen Anne Stakes and Prix Jacques le Marois. The victory in France lifted him into an exclusive club of just three horses who have won the Deauville contest on back-to-back occasions.

There was tough competition to acquire the St Albans Bloodstock-bred Frankel colt out of Qushchi at Book 1 but the hammer came down on 925,000gns to M. V. Magnier.

BREEDER INSIGHT

Haras d'Haspel

Haras d'Haspel is a business with big ambitions. The aim for José Delmotte's Normandy-based operation is to progress to become "amongst the leading vendors and breeders in France".

In 2021, a sizeable step was taken to fulfilling such a wish with Haras d'Haspel homebred Native Trail taking the European two-year-old division by storm with back-to-back Group 1 victories in the National Stakes and the Dewhurst Stakes.

Many people took immense pleasure in the success of the Godolphin-trained colt, who is by Oasis Dream. Native Trail is also out of a dam with Banstead Manor Stud connections. Needleleaf, a third-generation Juddmonte homebred, was purchased by Marc-Antoine Berghgracht of MAB Agency for Haras d'Haspel as an unraced two-year-old at the 2015 Tattersalls December Mare Sale.

"Needleleaf was quite an obvious choice, being a full sister to two Stakes fillies African Rose and Helleborine, both at stud for Juddmonte. And buying from Juddmonte we could also expect, sooner or later, some nice updates on the pedigree," says Berghgracht, who has returned to the same draft in subsequent years on behalf of Haras d'Haspel by whom he is engaged as racing and breeding manager.

"We are both big fans of the Juddmonte operation – racing and breeding – and have bought at least one from its December consignment for the last five years as well as using its stallions. We both love Oasis Dream, being well proven, a fair fee and crossing very well with Observatory mares....so we did it."

Native Trail was sold at Arqana in 2019 as "a big and strong foal" for €50,000. By the time his sister by Kingman went through the same ring in August, 2021, Native Trail had landed the Group 2 Superlative Stakes. The big difference between their two sales prices was that she had a '€9' in front of the 50,000!

That was a wonderful result for Haras d'Haspel and the good news has just kept coming through Native Trail's racecourse feats. For José Delmotte, his daughter Sandra and son-in-law Yannick – who are both in charge of the 300-hectare farm – it's a reward for all their hard work and vision with Berghgracht describing Native Trail's achievements as "a dream come true" for the family.

"They watched both Group 1 wins with all their staff and shared all together some magic moments, full of emotional tears," says Berghgracht.

And, of course, there is Native Trail's Classic campaign to look forward to. There's also a half-sister by Siyouni on the ground, while Needleleaf is currently in foal to Cracksman.

These are indeed exciting times for Delmotte and his team. Not that anyone is resting on their laurels at Haras d'Haspel, currently home to around 50 mares.

"The plan is to improve the stock step by step," says Berghgracht. "Still plenty to do...!"

BREEDER INSIGHT

Cheveley Park Stud

Cheveley Park Stud has long been associated with a series of top-class racehorses and 2021 saw another emerge in the form of Inspiral.

The Thompson family's homebred filly out of Starscope remains unbeaten after four foot-perfect performances in her two-year-old campaign.

In powering to a convincing success in the May Hill Stakes at Doncaster in September, the John and Thady Gosden-trained Inspiral became Frankel's 50th Group winner. And her juvenile season was complete when she gave her owner-breeders a thrilling triumph in the Group 1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket.

Inspiral is the second Group winner by Frankel that Cheveley Park Stud have bred from a Selkirk mare. They had previously mated Red Bloom to Frankel, producing Senator who became Simply Brilliant after he'd been sold to Hong Kong.

Here, Cheveley Park Stud's managing director Chris Richardson reflects on Inspiral's story to date – and looks forward to the next chapter....

"As a physical, Inspiral stood out in the paddocks. But I think the first indication we got was when she was broken in by our one of our great friends and a former employee of Cheveley Park Stud, Ed Peate at Penny Farm. Ed said to me early on, 'I think this filly is very special'.

"She was with Ed for quite a lot of spring and then went into John's (Gosden). He was pretty swiftly on the telephone saying, 'I like what I'm seeing'. Robert Havlin rode her when she broke her maiden at Newmarket and I think we started to get really excited by Frankie's comments after her Listed win at Sandown Park. He said to me, 'We've got one'.

"After her second start and indeed after the May Hill where she was so impressive, he said, 'This is a special filly, but she still feels weak'. So there was a little bit of a discussion as to whether we went for the Fillies' Mile. But Mrs Thompson felt that was the race that she would like Inspiral to target. As everybody saw there, she's a filly with a frame still and will, I'm sure, blossom over the winter and hopefully improve further.

"We winter on wonderful memories and great expectations. We'll go race to race. The Guineas will be her intended target all being well. Whether she has a prep race before that will depend on how she is in the spring. But trip-wise I can see her progressing to certainly a mile and a quarter. So, the Prix de Diane could be on the cards going forward. Whether she's an Oaks filly – her mum was more of a miler, second in the Guineas, second in the Coronation... I would like to see more proof that a mile and a half would be within her remit.

"As everybody knows, it hasn't been an easy year for the Thompson family. To have a filly like this was a huge lift to Patricia Thompson and the family. It's something that the operation has been striving for, for over 40 years – quality."
